

WHAT TO BRING

Documents you will need to complete your 2012-2013 FAFSA

Not all items apply to every student. Bring only the things that apply to you.

- Your Social Security Number (shown on your Social Security card)
- Your parents' Social Security numbers
- Your alien registration card, if you are not a U.S. citizen
- W-2 forms, final 2011 paycheck stubs, or other records of money earned by you and your parents in 2011
- Your 2011 federal income tax return (and your spouse's return if you are married), if already prepared
- Your parents' 2011 federal income tax return, if already prepared
- Records of untaxed income received by you and your parents in 2011—for example, Social Security, TANF, veteran's benefits, or military or clergy allowances
- Current bank statements, if you and/or your parents have a bank account
- A list of colleges or universities that you might be interested in attending during the 2012-2013 school year

Some students will need to bring additional records, such as:

- Business or farm records, including current mortgage information
- Current records of stocks, bonds, or other investments
